

**Confirming The Appointment Of Kelly McMullen As Director Of The Office For The Aging**

WHEREAS, further pursuant to Sections C-92 of the Ulster County Charter and Sections A23-1 of the Administrative Code, the above-referenced appointment is subject to confirmation by the Ulster County Legislature; now, therefore, be it
