WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 394 dated November 18, 2014, the Ulster County Legislature created the Ulster County Solid Waste Management Improvement Commission for the purpose of comprehensively reviewing the technologies, grant funding and host benefits available to newly established solid waste disposal facilities; and
