ULSTER COUNTY PLANNING BOARD Minutes - April 3, 2013

The Executive Committee met at 6:30PM

Chairman Watkins called the meeting to order and asked Mr. Leibowitz to read the roll call.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The March meeting minutes were approved. Motion by Mr. Konior second by Mr. Lovelett. Mr. Calimano abstained. All were in favor.

The February minutes were approved. Motion by Mr. Konior second by Mr. Lovelett. Mr. Calimano abstained. All were in favor.

3. FINANCIAL REPORT

Mr. Doyle informed the Board that the Office of Business Services finances will be reported quarterly. Mr. Doyle stated that the UCTC recently adopted the Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) for the year for about \$800,000 of work and are beginning to implement some of the studies. Mr. Doyle stated that RFPs are going out for two consultant studies. He added that we should have Federal approval by mid-April for the UPWP. Mr. Doyle stated that we are awaiting approximately \$180,000 in reimbursements from NYSDOT for work done in 2012.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT

Aja Hudson spoke to the board regarding her proposed garden design and installation business in Rosendale.

5. COMMUNITY REPORT

There was no community report.

6. **COMMUNICATIONS**

Mr. Doyle made note of the above.

Mr. Doyle stated there is a CFA process training session being held in the UC Legislature Chambers on April 23rd at noon. He urged anyone not familiar with the process to attend. CFA announcements should be made in May with awards being made in late summer.

Mr. Doyle informed the board that the 4th annual Ashokan Watershed Conference at the Ashokan Center in Olivebridge will be held from 9:00AM-3:00PM on Saturday, April 27th.

7. OLD BUSINESS

a. Greenway Update

Mr. Leibowitz stated the last Greenway meeting was held on February 27th. He stated they were trying to find ways to differentiate our Compact from Orange County's Greenway Compact. Mr. Leibowitz explained that they are making the focus on geographies first; then adding concepts such as housing and built environment. The next meeting is set for Tuesday, April 16th at 10AM. Mr. Leibowitz added that we have prepared a map. Mr. Doyle stated that anyone interested is welcome to attend. He added that the Supervisor from Marbletown, a consultant from Kingston, our consultant, several board members and staff have been present at meetings. Chairman Watkins added that more work needs to be done and any input is welcome. He stated that this will be our tool to bring to the communities. Mr. Leibowitz stated we hope to have the draft compact in June.

b. <u>SEQRA – DRAFT Full EAF Workbook available for public review and comment</u>

Mr. Doyle made note of the above and stated the new EAF forms go into effect in October. Mr. Doyle stated that he has contacted DEC and requested a training session for Ulster County. He added that the Department of Environment and the County Attorney's Office are looking at the workbook; our staff was not prepared to make comments on it.

<u>Streamlining the Referral Review Process</u> – Mr. Doyle stated that attorneys, working with staff, are looking at the local law we submitted, which would allow staff to review certain referrals without the board. Mr. Doyle added that the By-Laws are in the same place, but we have made the referral review process our focus for now.

8. SPECIAL TOPICS DISCUSSION

- a. Mr. Doyle stated the county continues to move the STRIVE project forward. We have completed a conceptual design for the school including parking and access facilities. We will be asking the school board by referendum to sell the building to the county. Mr. Doyle stated we have the proof of concept; we need the design work done and SEQRA work and the neighbors need to be contacted.
- b. Mr. Doyle stated we are actively involved with rail trail issues. The Transportation Council is programming federal funds for some of the rail trail connections, we continue to engage non-profits, we have requested resolutions of support from communities, we have studied the feasibility of rail with trail in Kingston but do not think they are feasible with the disturbances and dollar amounts needed to construct.
- c. Mr. Doyle stated that we are involved in the sub-division of the Golden Hill Nursing home property. The county has its own water supply in that system and there are shared services for that campus that need to be separated. Mr. Doyle added that we are looking at reciprocal easements, which will need approval by Kingston's Common Council.

9. NEW BUSINESS

a. <u>Environmental Notice Bulletin & Grant Opportunities</u>

Mr. Doyle made note of the DEC Technical Assistance Grants, which are eligible for community groups.
