

**Resolution No. 202 June 17, 2014**

**Amending The 2014 Ulster County Budget to Accept And Appropriate Additional Workforce Investment Act And Temporary Assistance For Needy Families Funding – Department Of Employment And Training**

Chairman of the Economic Development, Tourism, Housing, Planning and Transit Committee, Thomas J. Briggs, and Deputy Chairman James F. Maloney offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Employment and Training; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ulster County Department of Employment and Training requests that the 2014 Ulster County Budget be amended to accept an additional \$232,025.00 in funding under the Federal Workforce Investment Act (CFDA #17.258, 17.259, 17.278) and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (CFDA #93.558) allocations; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Employment and Training will subsidize occupational skills education, on-the-job training services and its Summer Youth Employment Program with these funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the 2014 Ulster County Budget is hereby amended as follows:
