

Approving The Execution Of A Contract Amendment In Excess Of \$50,000.00 Entered Into By The County – Department Of Social Services

Referred to: The Social Services Committee (Chairman Wawro and Legislators Lopez, Richard Parete, Rodriguez, and Ronk) and The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Gregorius, Maio, Maloney, Provenzano, Rodriguez and Ronk)

Chairman of the Social Services Committee, Mary Wawro, and Deputy Chairman Hector S. Rodriguez offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, an amendment for execution by the County with Berkshire Farm Center & Services for Youth has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

Department of Social services	Berkshire Farm Center & Services for Youth	Amendment No. 2 to Agreement for a Crisis Respite Program & related services for foster children & families residing in the County and have caseworkers with DSS Children’s Coordinated Services and Mental Health. The services provided are mandated by NYS & are paid by NYS through its Welfare Management System (WMS). The breakdown of shared costs between County, State & Federal is different for each child served because each child’s individual eligibility for the services is different. The estimated average County share is 32 %. The NYS Comptrollers Office audits the accounts annually. This Amendment extends the term of the Agreement for an additional year pursuant to the RFP and increases available funding.
