Chairman of the Economic Development and Tourism Committee, James F. Maloney, and Deputy Chairman Peter M. Loughran offer the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section C-11(O) of the Ulster County Charter and Section A2-5(15) of the Administrative Code, the Ulster County Legislature shall have the power to approve the execution of certain contracts and amendments in the amount of \$50,000.00 or in excess of \$50,000.00 entered into by the County; and

WHEREAS, a contract for execution by the County with Luminary Publishing, Inc. has been submitted for approval by the Ulster County Legislature, which is described below:

The vendor will also produce a digital travel guide for the County Tourism's website. 40% of the proceeds from the sales of advertising space shall be used to offset the cost of producing the Travel Guide and as such the contribution percentage in the following column are estimated.
