Saturday, November 1st : 9 AM – 12 PM

As always, the Board of Elections office is open Monday – Friday from 9 AM – 5 PM. Applications for an Absentee Ballot must be postmarked no later than October 28th, or personally delivered to the BOE by November 3rd.
