

New Business:

Audit of the Sheriff's Department

Legislator Bartels raised the issue of an audit of the Sheriff's Department. She asked the committee members to consider if they want to do a separate RFP for such an audit and seek a firm with specialized experience with this type of audit.

Comptroller Auerbach brought up the fact that the Sheriff's Office is made up of three divisions (Civil, Corrections and Road Patrol) and suggested the committee clarify which division they would want an audit to focus on and what would be the objective of the audit. He said this would be important to outline before the committee seeks a firm to do the audit.

Comptroller Auerbach then discussed audits done by specialized firms and the audits his office has done on various areas within the Sheriff's Department.
