Hudson Valley Film Commission

A request for Contract for Services, originally presented by Laurent Rejto of the Hudson Valley Film Commission at the March 11, 2015 meeting of the Ulster County Industrial Development Agency, was reviewed. The request was in the amount of \$50,000, an increase of \$10,000 from last year's application. Discussion included, but was not limited to the proposed increase. It was suggested that Mr. Rejto return to the Corporation in July or August to provide an updated presentation for consideration of the additional \$10,000 request. A copy of the presentation materials is on file.

Motion: James Malcolm, seconded by John Morrow, moved to award \$40,000.00 to the Hudson Valley Film Commission.

Vote: The motion was adopted. Floyd Lattin voting no.

New Tablets for Board Members

Suzanne Holt suggested the members of the Corporation consider investing in I-Pads/Tablets for members as a means to decrease the use of paper. Costs will be investigated and reported back to the Corporation.

Chair Horodyski opened the meeting for public comment. There were no individuals who requested the Privilege of the Floor. The public comment section of the Agenda was closed.

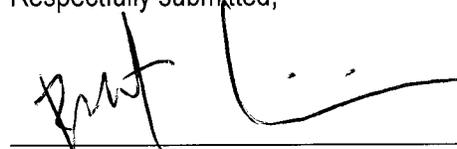
ADJOURNMENT
