RE: RESOLUTION REQUEST FOR AUDIO/VIDEO GRANT

WE HAVE BEEN APPROVED FOR A GRANT OF \$35,514.00 FOR UPDATING AUDIO/VIDEO RECORDING EQUIPMENT IN 9 POLICE AGENCIES THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY. I AM WRITING TO REQUEST THAT YOU CONSIDER A RESOLUTION IN YOUR OCTOBER SESSION ALLOWING THE COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE NINE AGENCIES INVOLVED. THE RESOLUTION FOR THE GRANT WAS APPROVED IN MARCH, 2014. SINCE THEN WE HAVE BEEN WORKING WITH THE 9 AGENCIES TO SEE WHAT EQUIPMENT IS NEEDED AND THE CONTRACT HAD TO GO OUT FOR BID.
