## Technology in Planning and Environmental Analysis

This seminar is an overview of the available technology that can be integrated into local and regional planning, environmental conservation decision-making and the public involvement process. It will introduce Ulster County's updated web mapping tool, various geographic information system (GIS) applications and data sets, and demonstrate their use in comprehensive planning, natural resource inventories and site plan review. Other technologies, such as traffic micro-simulations and visualization tools, will also be introduced and illustrated as to how and when to apply these technologies to regional and site specific analyses. The seminar will also highlight technologies that can improve the efficiency and ability of boards to work together and better inform the public.
