

Approving Permit Between Ulster County Community College For Use Of Space At The Business Resource Center At Development Court By The NYS Department Of Labor

The Economic Development / Education, Tourism and Cultural Affairs Committee (Chairman Harris and Legislators Cummings, Felicello, Roberti, Bartels, Loughran and Zimet) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Community College leases space from the County at Development Court in the Town of Ulster for use as a Business Resource Center and for classroom use, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Labor has requested a permit to occupy a portion of such space on a month-to-month basis for \$37,479.00 annual rent, and

WHEREAS the Department of Labor has requested that the Ulster County Legislature approve such permit, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development/Education, Tourism and Cultural Affairs Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature approves the permit to be issued by Ulster County Community College for use of space at Development Court by the NYS Department of Labor as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
