

Abandonment Of Portion Of County Road Number 61 To The Town Of New Paltz Situated In The Town Of New Paltz

The Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee (Chairman Felicello and Legislators Hathaway, McAfee, Meyer, Stock, Berardi, Donaldson, Provenzano and Zimet) and Legislators Alfonso and Busick offer the following:

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster has no further use of a portion of County owned Road Number 61 located in the Town of New Paltz more fully described in the legal description filed with the Clerk of the Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works recommends its abandonment to the adjoining owner, and

WHEREAS, the Highways & Bridges / Buildings & Grounds / Public Works Administration Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 118-A of the Highway Law the County of Ulster abandons the said described portion of County Road Number 61 to the Town of New Paltz situated in the Town of New Paltz, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Legislature is authorized to execute a deed conveying such parcel to the Town of New Paltz and any other documents necessary to reflect such transfer,

and moves its adoption.
