

Amending The 2007 Ulster County Budget – Child Support Incentive Allocation – Social Services

The Human Development Committee (Chairman Kraft and Legislators Distel, Liepmann, Loughran, R.A. Parete, Harris and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requests that the 2007 Ulster County Budget be amended to accept a federal allocation for Child Support Incentive funds in the amount of \$60,865.00, and

WHEREAS, the funding has been awarded to Ulster County Social Services as the local social service district based upon a federal formula which takes into consideration five key child support areas: paternity establishment, support order establishment, current collection, arrears collections and cost effectiveness, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
