WHEREAS, the Ulster County Deputy Sheriffs Police Benevolent Association, Inc. (PBA), an affiliate organization of the New York State Union of Police Association, Inc., has requested voluntary recognition from the Employer (County and Sheriff) of the PBA for a separate Superior Officers Unit, and

WHEREAS, this unit consists of all patrol Deputy Sheriff Lieutenant(s), Deputy Sheriff Detective Lieutenant(s) and Deputy Sheriff Captain(s), and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that a separate organization, entitled the "Superior Officers Unit" be voluntarily recognized by the County of Ulster and the Ulster County Deputy Sheriffs Police Benevolent Association, Inc. (PBA) as an authorized employee Labor Relations Negotiating Unit which will represent all Deputy Sheriff Lieutenant(s), Deputy Sheriff Detective Lieutenant(s) and Deputy Sheriff Captain(s), and moves its adoption.
