WHEREAS, Article III, Section 1, provides that the term of office of the Personnel Officer of Ulster County shall be six (6) years, and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Officer Screening Committee has met and reviewed applications and recommends the appointment of Randall V. Roth.

RESOLVED, that Randall V. Roth is hereby appointed Personnel Officer for the County of Ulster to fill the unexpired term, said term to expire November 19, 2009,
