**"SECTION 4. CERTAIN POLITICAL OFFICES PROHIBITED**

No elected *County* official, nor any *County* Department Head, nor any *County* Commissioner or Chairperson of any County Committee, Commission or Board shall hold the office of Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer or any other executive office in any ~~town or~~ County political party *or* political ~~club or association,~~ ~~society or~~ committee.

The foregoing shall not preclude any candidate for elected office from holding any office within his or her own political campaign committee even if that campaign committee provides for one or more candidates."
