

Resolution No. 16 January 22, 2013

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With The New York State Division Of Homeland Security And Emergency Services For Overtime Reimbursement– Ulster County Sheriff’s Office

Referred to: The Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee (Chairman Parete and Legislators Belfiglio, Ronk, Briggs and Maio) and the Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Harris, Maio, Maloney, Gregorius, Provenzano & Rodriguez)

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Richard A. Parete, and Deputy Chairman Kenneth Ronk offer the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff’s Office participated in the “Hudson River Spider Operation” which had as an objective, the prevention of terrorist attacks by enhancing law enforcement’s capability to support international border and waterway security by disrupting and deterring criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff’s Office participation in this operation is important to help promote homeland security by, among other objectives, collecting data on the movement of foreign-flagged vessels, and then communicating the data to the United States Coast Guard; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff is requesting that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, for the period September 1, 2012 through September 30, 2012 in the amount of \$4,820.00 to reimburse the Ulster County Sheriff’s Office the cost of the overtime associated with “Hudson River Spider Operation;” now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services for overtime reimbursement in the amount of \$ 4,820.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney;

and move its adoption.
