

Adopting Introductory Local Law No. 4 Of 2012 [A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 5 Of 2008 (A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 5 Of 1999 To Increase The Income Range By Which Senior Land Owners With Limited Income Are Eligible For A Partial County Tax Exemption On Their Residence.)] Hereinafter Known As Local Law No. 1 of 2012
