WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Health Bureau of Supplemental Food Programs is distributing cost of living adjustments (COLA's) in the amount of \$6,294.00 for the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program (Contract No. C-019387) for the period October 1, 2006 – September 30, 2007, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Ulster County Public Health is requesting that the 2007 Ulster County Budget be amended to accept the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program COLA funds which will be used to fund Nutrition Counseling Services, and

WHEREAS, there is no increased County contribution associated with this transaction, and

WHEREAS, the Health Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
