

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A License Agreement With The Arts Society of Kingston, Inc., Granting Use Of The Visitors Wing Of The Old Jail For A Sculpture Exhibit For An Eight Week Period

The Arts, Education, Tourism and Community Relations Committee (Chairman Zimet and Legislators Bischoff, Cahill, Lomita, Sheeley, Felicello and Harris) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Arts Society of Kingston, Inc., has proposed use of the Visitors Wing of the old County Jail for a sculpture exhibit for an eight week period, and

WHEREAS, the Arts Society of Kingston, Inc., has agreed to pay all County Expenses associated with this temporary relocation, and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary for the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to be authorized to execute a license agreement with the Arts Society of Kingston, Inc., for use of the Visitors Wing of the old County Jail allowing occupancy for an eight week period, and

WHEREAS, the Arts, Education, Tourism and Community Relations Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to execute on behalf of the County, a license agreement with the Arts Society of Kingston, Inc., for use of the Visitors Wing of the old County Jail allowing for occupancy for an eight week period, as annexed hereto and filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
