

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Contract With The New York State Department Of Health To Renew The Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program – Public Health

The Health Committee (Chairman R.S. Parete and Legislators Liepmann, Sheeley, Stoeckeler, Terpening, Busick and Roberti) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Health requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C-020224) in the amount of \$45,000.00, with the New York State Department of Health to renew the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, for the period April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2008, and

WHEREAS, programs will be used to support and enhance local efforts to reduce the prevalence of elevated blood lead levels in children through the implementation of a comprehensive program of primary and secondary prevention which includes: public and professional outreach and education; collaboration with local primary care providers for screening, diagnostic evaluation, medical management, education and environmental interventions, and

WHEREAS, the Health Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a contract (Contract No. C-020224) in the amount of \$45,000.00, with the New York State Department of Health to renew the Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program, for the period April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2008, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
