

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With The State University Of New York At New Paltz For The Erection And Maintenance Of Bus Shelters – Department of Public Transportation (Ulster County Area Transit)

The Economic Development and Tourism Committee Chairman James F. Maloney, and Deputy Chairman Peter M. Loughran, offer the following:

WHEREAS, the County presently operates a public transit system throughout Ulster County, including ingress and egress to the State University of New York at New Paltz (SUNY-New Paltz) campus; and

WHEREAS, the County and SUNY-New Paltz desire to enhance the public transportation service and improve passenger safety and convenience through the installation of bus shelters on the SUNY New Paltz campus; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Transportation is requesting that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature execute an intermunicipal agreement with SUNY-New Paltz for the distribution of bus shelters currently in the County’s inventory; and

WHEREAS, SUNY-New Paltz will be responsible for installation and upkeep of the shelters, as well as for maintenance of adequate insurance coverage; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized to execute a bus shelter agreement, and any amendments thereto, with SUNY-New Paltz, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and moves its adoption.
