

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A Renewal Agreement With The City Of Kingston And The County Of Ulster To Provide A Dedicated Work Crew For Alternatives (Community Service) – Probation

WHEREAS, the Director of Probation has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a renewal agreement with the City of Kingston and the County of Ulster to provide a dedicated work crew for Alternatives (community service), term of said agreement from January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute a renewal agreement with the City of Kingston and the County of Ulster, to provide a dedicated work crew for Alternatives (community service), term of said agreement from January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2008, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
