

Amending The 2005 Ulster County Budget – Mental Health Department

The Mental Health / Public Health / Residential Services Committee (Chairmen Busick and Roberti and Legislators Alfonso, McAfee, Provenzano, R.S. Parete and Stoeckeler) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS) provides funding in the form of State Aid to Gateway Community Industries, and

WHEREAS, this funding has heretofore been provided via direct contract between OASAS and Gateway Community Industries, and

WHEREAS, OASAS has requested that these funds now be passed through the Ulster County Mental Health Department to Gateway Community Industries via contract, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Mental Health Department is in agreement with this contractual pass-through because it affords local control over the service, and

WHEREAS, there is no increased County contribution associated with this transaction, and

WHEREAS, Gateway Community Industries does not object to this arrangement, and

WHEREAS, the Mental Health/Public Health/Residential Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval.
