

**Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Inter-Municipal ~~Shared Services~~ Agreement With Town Of Saugerties For Maintenance Of County Roads – Department Of Public Works (Highways And Bridges)**

The Public Works and Capital Projects Committee (Chairman Fabiano and Legislators Felicello, Maloney, Roberts, Hochberg, Loughran and Provenzano) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Public Works (Highways and Bridges), and

WHEREAS, Sections 133-a, 135, and 135-a of Article 6 of the New York State Highway Law provide authorization for the County to enter into inter-municipal agreements with towns for the maintenance of County roads and for the leasing of the County's highway machinery, tools or equipment to towns for the purpose of maintaining County roads, subject to approval by resolution of both the Ulster County Legislature and the respective town board, and

WHEREAS, some County roads are so located that it is more efficient and less costly to the County for towns to perform summer light maintenance, snow removal, and winter-related maintenance on these roads, and

WHEREAS, a 1.00-mile length of County Road 89 (Malden Turnpike) and a 0.99-mile length of County Road 118 (Glasco Turnpike), both in the Town of Saugerties, are so located that it would be more efficient for the Town of Saugerties to maintain them, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Commissioner of Public Works has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature execute an Inter-Municipal ~~Shared Services~~ Agreement with the Town of Saugerties for the Town to perform summer light maintenance, snow removal, and winter-related maintenance on these roads, which total 1.99 centerline miles, for the fixed fee of \$13,333.00, from the period beginning October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, and

WHEREAS, the winter-related services to be provided by the Town of Saugerties include plowing the entire width of roadways and shoulders, benching, removal of snow at intersections, sanding and salting the road, and treatment of slippery spots including "black ice," and

WHEREAS, the summer light maintenance services to be provided by the Town of Saugerties include cleaning ditches along the roadway, cleaning culverts when necessary, repairing potholes, cutting brush up to four inches in diameter, trimming trees below the ten foot level, and mowing the roadside area once, and
