WHEREAS, County Law Article 9 §450, General Municipal Law Article 5-G § 119-1 and Local Law Number 5 of 1980, §1d, provides that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is the only person, when supported by a resolution, who can enter into an inter-municipal agreement on behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Department of Social Services has inter-municipal agreements pertaining to various programs, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized per this resolution, to execute the inter-municipal agreements for the following programs with the municipalities as indicated below:

Community Work Experience Program – City of Kingston, Town of Denning, Town of Esopus, Town of Gardiner, Town of Kingston, Town of Lloyd, Town of Marbletown, Town of Marlboro, Town of New Paltz, Town of Olive, Town of Plattekill, Town of Rochester, Town of Shandaken, Town of Shawangunk, Town of Ulster and Town of Wawarsing, Town of Woodstock, and Village of Saugerties, and

Domestic Violence Unit – City of Kingston, State Police Finance and Town of Ulster, and

Youth Bureau – City of Kingston

, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is authorized per this resolution to execute the inter-municipal agreements for the various programs identified in the body of this resolution, as well as amendments to said agreements with the municipalities identified and others, as they may be identified
