WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Ulster County Department of Social Services has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into agreement with the New York State Department of Health for the Early Intervention Program (Contract No. C-021828) for the term of October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the New York State Department of Health for the Early Intervention Program (Contract No. C-021828) for the term of October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009, in the form as on file with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, the position (and/or program) will be eliminated as well,

and moves its adoption.
