

Adopting Introductory Local Law No. 12 Of 2007 (A Local Law Amending Local Law Number 8 Of 1991 Ulster County Mandatory Source Separation And Recycling Law), Hereinafter Known As Local Law Number 8 Of 2007

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 184, dated May 9, 2007, set the date for Public Hearing on Introductory Local Law Number 12 Of 2007 (A Local Law Amending Local Law Number 8 Of 1991 Ulster County Mandatory Source Separation And Recycling Law) to be held on Wednesday, June 6, 2007 at 6:45 PM in the Student Lounge, Vanderlyn Hall, Ulster County Community College, Stone Ridge, New York, and

WHEREAS, all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak on behalf of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, and

WHEREAS, based upon the examination of the Ulster County Legislature, and pursuant to Part 617 of the implementary regulations pertaining to Article 8 of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), it has been determined that the adoption of this proposed Local Law constitutes a Type II action as defined under 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(20) and (27) and does not require any determination or procedure under SEQRA, and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Introductory Local Law herein is hereby adopted by the Ulster County Legislature, and hereinafter known as Local Law Number 8 of 2007,
