WHEREAS, the Director of Ulster County Probation has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute an agreement (M085501) with New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives for the Alternatives to Incarceration/Community Corrections Facility Programs for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$131,000.00, and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to provide support for the provision of Alternatives to Incarceration Services which includes receiving shelter and benefits, for men and women who have committed crimes and have substance abuse problems through the Ulster County Community Corrections Facility, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an agreement (M085501) with New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives for the Alternatives to Incarceration/Community Corrections Facility Programs for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$131,000.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
