

Appointing David Sheeley As Acting Commissioner Of Ulster County Department Of Public Works

The Public Works Committee (Chairman Berardi and Legislators Bischoff, Cahill, Dart, Lomita, Stoeckeler, Fabiano, Felicello and McAfee) offers the following:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 180 dated May 9, 2007, Local Law No. 5 of 2007, Section I creates the Establishment of the Department of Public Works, and provides for the appointment of the Commissioner of Public Works, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint David Sheeley as Acting Commissioner of Public Works until such time as a permanent Commissioner of Public Works is appointed, and

WHEREAS, in accordance to the stipulations of Local Law No. 5 of 2007, the term of office of the first Commissioner of Public Works is to expire on December 31, 2008, and thereafter, the term of office of such Commissioner shall be two years, expiring on 31st day of December of each even numbered year, this appointment will expire December 31, 2008, or until such time that a permanent Commissioner of Public Works is appointed, at the discretion of the Ulster County Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has met and reviewed said appointment with a majority of members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said appointment with a majority of members voting approval, and

RESOLVED, that David Sheeley is hereby appointed as Acting Commissioner of Public Works until December 31, 2008 or until such time that a permanent Commissioner of Public Works is appointed, at the discretion of the Ulster County Legislature,

and moves its adoption.
