

**Authorizing The County Treasurer To Accept A Bid For Private Sale On A Parcel Of County Owned Property**

The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Lomita and Legislators Bartels, Berardi, Gregorius, Provenzano, Zimet, Cummings, Gerentine and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has requested permission to accept a bid for a parcel of County owned property as hereinafter described, acquired by the County by reason of nonpayment of taxes and has been offered at Public Auction, and

WHEREAS, Parcel No. 39 of the 2007 Public Auction, listed as 142 x 240, in the Town of Shawangunk, section block and lot number 99.1-7-3.120, has unpaid taxes in the amount of \$3,648.23 dating back to the year 1995, and

WHEREAS, the prospective purchaser has bid \$440.00 for the property, which falls within the price range determined upon review by the Real Property Tax Service Agency, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Treasurer is authorized to accept payment as follows:
