

Resolution No. 24 January 22, 2013

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into An Agreement With New York State To Accept Funds For A Local Government Records Management Improvement Fund Grant (Historical Records Category)

Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee, Richard A. Gerentine, and Deputy Chairman Donald J. Gregorius offer the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Clerk has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into an agreement with New York State to accept funds for a Local Government Records Management Improvement Fund Grant (LGRMIF); and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Clerk's Office was awarded a LGRMIF Grant in the Historical Records Category for 2012-2013 in the amount of \$11,051.00; and

WHEREAS, the LGRMIF Grant will be used to create a teaching packet which will be appropriate for fourth through seventh grades and pertains to local Dutch colonial history found in the County-owned Matthew Persen House Museum; and

WHEREAS, the teaching packet will include lesson plans and learning activities which meet the 2005 New York State Social Studies Standards as well as the new English Language Arts Common Core Standards; and

WHEREAS, the curriculum will be developed to give students an opportunity to examine and interpret documents from the Ulster County Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Clerk's Office will receive the first revenue installment of \$5,525.00 in the year 2013, which represents 50% of the total grant award from the State; and

WHEREAS, the remaining balance will be received after the Final Expenditure Report has been submitted and approved by the Grants Finance Center; and

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with New York State to accept funds for a Local Government Records Management Improvement Fund Grant (Historical Records Category) for the County Clerk's Office in the amount of \$11,051.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified by the County Attorney's Office; and, be it further
