

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services For Participation In Operation IMPACT IX – District Attorney – Ulster County Sheriff – Department Of Probation

Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee, Richard A. Parete, and Deputy Chairman Kenneth Ronk offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County District Attorney, the Ulster County Sheriff and the Department of Probation; and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County District Attorney has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to sign an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services for the purpose of participating in a twelve-month joint County crime reduction program, for the period July 1, 2012 thru June 30, 2013, designated as Operation IMPACT IX in Ulster County; and

WHEREAS, Operation IMPACT IX is an expanded crime reduction program related to criminal activity identified as drug use and gang violence, and will involve the Ulster County Offices of the County Sheriff, District Attorney, and Probation, at an approximate cost of \$176,700.00; and

WHEREAS, each County dollar spent under the Operation IMPACT IX initiative is 100% reimbursable by the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to sign an agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services, for the purpose of participating in Operation IMPACT IX for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature, or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, Counsel to the County Legislature, Chairman of the County Legislature, and the Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee; and, be it further

RESOLVED, if funding for this program is eliminated, this program will be eliminated as well,
