

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute A License Agreement With Historic Kingston Waterfront, KOSCO, LLC, For Boat Docking Space On Rondout – Sheriff’s Office

The Criminal Justice and Safety Committee (Chairman Dart and Legislators Briggs, R.A. Parete, Zimet, Aiello, Hansut and Ronk) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Sheriff has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a license agreement with Historic Kingston Waterfront, KOSCO, LLC, 325 Gold Street, 4th Floor, Brooklyn, New York 11201, for boat docking space on the Rondout for the Sheriff’s patrol boat, and

WHEREAS, there will be no cost to the County associated with this license agreement, and

WHEREAS, in any event the licensee, the County of Ulster, shall have the option to terminate the license agreement for any reason or for no reason, upon 30 days written notice to the licensor, Historic Kingston Waterfront, KOSCO, LLC, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Capital Projects Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to execute a license agreement with Historic Kingston Waterfront, KOSCO, LLC, 325 Gold Street, 4th Floor, Brooklyn, New York 11201, for boat docking space on the Rondout for the Sheriff’s patrol boat, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
