

Amending Resolution No. 174, Dated May 9, 2007 To Include Other Municipalities For The Community Work Experience Program – Social Services

The Human Development Committee (Chairman Kraft and Legislators Distel, Liepmann, Loughran, R.A. Parete, Harris and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, County Law Article 9 § 450, General Municipal Law Article 5-G § 119-1 and Local Law 5 of the Year 1980 § 1d provides that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature, when supported by a resolution, is the only person who can enter into an inter-municipal agreement on behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 174 dated May 9, 2007, the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature was authorized to execute the inter-municipal agreements for various programs for the Ulster County Department of Social Services including the Community Work Experience Program, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Social Services requests that Resolution No. 174, be amended to include the Village of Saugerties, the Town of Woodstock, the Town of Kingston and the City of Kingston in the list of municipalities for the Community Work Experience Program, and

WHEREAS, the Human Development Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 174 dated May 9, 2007, authorizing the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to execute the inter-municipal agreements for the various programs identified in said resolution, be amended to include the Village of Saugerties, the Town of Woodstock, the Town of Kingston and the City of Kingston in the list of municipalities for the Community Work Experience Program,

and moves its adoption.
