WHEREAS, the Director of Ulster County Probation has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into agreement with the New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives for the Intensive Supervision Program (ISP) for the period January 1, 2006 through December 31, 2006, and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Safety Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the New York State Division of Probation and Correctional Alternatives for the Intensive Supervision Program (ISP), as filed with the Clerk of the Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
