WHEREAS, Grant Application Services funding is currently budgeted in the Ulster County Legislative Budget for the year 2007, and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator provides and monitors grant application procedures and advises County Departments of protocol for this program, and

WHEREAS, the Office of County Administrator is requesting that the Grant Application Services Program be transferred from the County Legislature to County Administration, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Grant Application Services Program be transferred from the County Legislature to County Administration effective August 9, 2007, and
