

Requesting Reappropriation Of Funds From Unanticipated Job Access Reverse Commute Revenue To Be Used For Local Match For Fuel Costs – Ulster County Area Transit

The Economic Development, Housing, Planning and Transit Committee (Chairman Rodriguez and Legislators Bischoff, Loughran, Sheeley, Harris, Roberti and Terrizzi) offers the following:

WHEREAS, Ulster County Area Transit has received unanticipated Job Access Reverse Commute revenue in the amount of \$65,647.73 and the Director of Public Transit is requesting that these funds be reappropriated for the local match for the purchase of fuel affected by the increase in fuel prices, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development, Housing, Planning and Transit Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the unanticipated Job Access Reverse Commute revenue (State Operating Assistance) in the amount of \$65,647.73 be used for the local match for the purchase of fuel, and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the 2008 Ulster County Budget is hereby amended as follows:
