

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into A Memorandum Of Understanding With The New York State Office Of Temporary And Disability Assistance (OTDA) For the Acquisition of Personal Computers – Department Of Social Services

The Social Services Committee (Chairman Wawro and Legislators Lopez, Ronk, Richard Parete and Rodriguez) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA) has been approved to purchase personal computers for the Ulster County Social Services district, to support timely and accurate case processing and administration of the Temporary Assistance (TA), Food Stamps (FS), Home Energy Assistance (HEAP) and Employment Programs, and

WHEREAS, OTDA is paying 100% of the purchase price, including shipping to the Ulster County Social Services District, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with OTDA for the acquisition and utilization of nineteen (19) personal computers provided by OTDA, and

WHEREAS, the Social Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding, and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance for the purpose of accepting nineteen (19) personal computers, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this program is eliminated, the program will be eliminated as well,
