

TERMINATING THE INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT DATED JUNE 16, 1998 REGARDING CERTAIN TAX CERTIORARIS INSTITUTED BY THE CITY OF NEW YORK

The General Services / Community Services Committee (Chairman Tipp and Legislators Every, Maloney, McAfee, Kraft, Rodriguez and Stoeckeler) and Legislators Bartels, Berardi, Dart, Donaldson, Feldmann, Hyatt, Lomita, Loughran, R.A. Parete, R.S. Parete, Provenzano, Shapiro, and Zimet offers the following:

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster entered into an intermunicipal agreement dated June 16, 1998 with the Towns of Hurley, Olive, Marbletown and Wawarsing to share the costs of defending certain tax certiorari proceedings then pending against the Town of Hurley and Olive, and

WHEREAS, said agreement has outlived its usefulness in that funding for the defense of a tax certiorari proceeding be brought by the City of New York against a watershed municipality is available to that municipality pursuant to Article V, Section 136 of the New York City Watershed Memorandum of Agreement, and

WHEREAS, the General Services/Community Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute the annexed Termination of Intermunicipal Agreement on behalf of the County of Ulster,

and moves its adoption.
