WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County STOP DWI Program, and

WHEREAS, Ulster County STOP DWI has submitted its 2011 Program Plan to the Governor's Traffic Safety Committee in accordance with New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 1197, and

WHEREAS, approval of the Program Plan by the State of New York will provide continued funding for the STOP DWI Program, and

WHEREAS, the services to be provided to Ulster County by the various police agencies, other municipal entities, and service organizations, as set forth in the Program Plan, are of value in Ulster County's effort to reduce the incidence of drunk and drugged driving, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Ulster County Legislature to enter into certain inter-municipal agreements to permit Ulster County STOP DWI to engage in the activities described in the Program Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Programs, Education and Community Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of its members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby approves Ulster County's 2011 STOP DWI Program Plan, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute such inter-municipal agreements, and any amendments thereto, as may be required to carry out the approved Program Plan, as such agreements are presented to the Clerk of the Legislature or as they are modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
