

**Adopting Introductory Local Law No. 7 Of 2008 (A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 5 Of 1999 – A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 1 Of 1987 As Amended By Local Law No. 1 Of 1999 To Increase The Income Range By Which Senior Land Owners With Limited Income Are Eligible For A Partial County Tax Exemption On Their Residence), Hereinafter Known As Local Law Number 5 Of 2008**

WHEREAS, based upon the examination of the Ulster County Legislature, and pursuant to Part 617 of the implementary regulations pertaining to Article 8 of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), it has been determined that the adoption of this proposed Local Law constitutes a Type II action as defined under 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(20) and (27) and does not require any determination or procedure under SEQRA, and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
