

AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE ULSTER COUNTY LEGISLATURE TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000.00 FOR THE ULSTER COUNTY OFFICE FOR THE AGING TO PURCHASE A MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION VAN – AMENDING 2004 BUDGET

WHEREAS, New York State Office for the Aging has awarded the Ulster County Office for the Aging a Grant-in-Aid in the amount of \$35,000.00 for equipment, and

WHEREAS, the Ulster County Office for the Aging allocated the money to purchase a new medical transportation van, and

WHEREAS, the General Services Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.
