

Resolution No. 311 December 18, 2012

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Agreement With The New York State Office Of Children And Family Services To Accept A Grant For The Child And Family Safety Program – Department Of Social Services

Referred to: The Social Services Committee (Chairman Wawro and Legislators Lopez, Ronk, Parete and Rodriguez) and the Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Gerentine and Legislators Harris, Maio, Maloney, Gregorius, Provenzano and Rodriguez)

Chairman of the Social Services Committee, Mary Wawro, and Deputy Chairman Hector S. Rodriguez offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Social Services; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Ulster County Department of Social Services requests that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature be authorized to enter into an agreement (NYS Contract # C026728), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Office of Children and Family Services for the Child and Family Safety Program, for the term February 1, 2013 through January 31, 2014, in the amount of \$149,722.00; and

WHEREAS, the funding will be used by the Multidisciplinary Team (MDT), Child Advocacy Center (CAC) and Child Fatality Review Team (CFRT) to improve coordination among law enforcement, child protective services, health care and other community agencies involved in child abuse investigations and the protection of abused and neglected children; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires no matching County funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement (NYS Contract # C026728), and any amendments thereto, with the New York State Office of Children and Family Services for the Child and Family Safety Program, in the amount of \$149,722.00, in the form as filed with the clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney; and, be it further

RESOLVED, that if funding for this program is eliminated, then the program will be eliminated as well,

and moves its adoption.
