

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Enter Into A Lease With Spring Lake Fire Department For Ulster County Central Auto Garage – Public Works

The Public Works Committee (Chairman Berardi and Legislators Bischoff, Cahill, Dart, Lomita, Stoeckeler, Fabiano, Felicello and McAfee) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the Acting Commissioner of Public Works has requested that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature to enter into a lease with the Spring Lake Fire Department for the Ulster County Central Auto Garage for a period of five (5) years, commencing September 15, 2008 through September 14, 2013, at an annual rent of \$25,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Spring Lake Fire Department to lease Ulster County Central Auto Garage for a period of five (5) years commencing September 15, 2008 through September 14, 2013, at an annual cost of \$25,000.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,

and moves its adoption.
