

Authorizing The Chairman Of The Ulster County Legislature To Execute An Inter-Municipal Agreement With The City Of Kingston For Providing Services For Firefighting Communication Purposes – Department Of Emergency Communications/Emergency Management

Legislator Jack Hayes, Chairman of The Law Enforcement and Public Safety Committee (Chairman Hayes and Legislators Belfiglio, Ronk, Sweeney, Briggs, Hochberg and Rodriguez) and Co-Sponsors: The Governmental Services, Environmental and Administrative Committee (Chairman Roberts and Legislators Belfiglio, Fabiano, Petit, Ronk, Richard Parete, Robert Parete, Rodriguez and Shapiro) offer the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Department of Emergency Communications/Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, New York State's General Municipal Law Article 5-G and Section A3-4 (Y) of the Ulster County Administrative Code provide that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature can enter into an inter-municipal agreement of behalf of the County of Ulster, and

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Kingston desire to enter into an inter-municipal agreement that would benefit the residents and taxpayers of the County and the City of Kingston, and

WHEREAS, the County currently operates a 911 and dispatch system through its Department of Emergency Communications/Emergency Management, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kingston currently operates and funds the City of Kingston Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, the County is in a position to provide the City of Kingston with services for firefighting communication purposes that will result in significant savings for the City of Kingston,

WHEREAS, the County and the City of Kingston will enter into an agreement that will take effect on January 1, 2011 and end on December 31, 2011, the same of which shall be subject to: an authorizing resolution of the Ulster County Legislature and approval of the Ulster County Executive; and an authorizing resolution of the City of Kingston Common Council and the approval of the Mayor of the City of Kingston, and

WHEREAS, the County of Ulster Department of Emergency Communications/Emergency Management will provide two-way radio communications between it and the City of Kingston Fire Department, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kingston shall pay the County the sum of \$75,000.00 as consideration for the services referenced herein, and

WHEREAS, the work to be performed under this Agreement constitutes a Type II action under Sections 2.20 and 4.2.3 of the County of Ulster's State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Type II List that was adopted in Resolution No. 118 on April 20, 2010, and

WHEREAS, as per Section 3 of the County's Type II List, this action does not pose a significant potential environmental impact and may be progressed as a Type II action in accordance with 6 NYCRR Part 617 of SEQRA, and

WHEREAS, the Governmental Services, Environmental and Administrative Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, and

WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Ulster County Legislature is hereby authorized to execute an Inter-Municipal Agreement with the City of Kingston, 420 Broadway, Kingston, New York, for providing the City of Kingston with services for firefighting communication purposes for the period January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, in the amount of \$75,000.00, in the form as filed with the Clerk of the Ulster County Legislature or as modified with the approval of the County Attorney,
