

**Authorizing The County Treasurer To Accept Bids For Private Sale On Parcels Of County Owned Property**

The Ways and Means Committee (Chairman Lomita and Legislators Cahill, Dart, Gregorius, Provenzano, Zimet, Cummings, Gerentine and Noonan) offers the following:

WHEREAS, the County Treasurer has requested permission to accept two bids for parcels of county owned property as hereinafter described, acquired by the County by reason of nonpayment of taxes and have been offered at Public Auction, and

WHEREAS, Parcel No. 16 of the 2007 Public Auction, listed as 5.2 acres, wet land, in the Town of New Paltz, section block and lot number 87.5-3-2.212, has unpaid taxes in the amount of \$1,291.51 dating back to the year 2004, and

WHEREAS, Parcel No. 64 of the 2007 Public Auction, listed as 2 acres, landlocked, in the Town of Wawarsing, section block and lot number 82.4-2-45, has unpaid taxes in the amount of \$2,437.63, dating back to the year 2004, and

WHEREAS, the prospective purchaser has bid \$200.00 for each property, which falls within the price range determined upon review by The Real Property Tax Service Agency, and

WHEREAS, the Ways and Means Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval.

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Treasurer is authorized to accept payment as follows:
