

Designating The Ulster County Tourism Office As The Official Tourist Promotion Agency Of Ulster County - Department Of Tourism

The Economic Development and Tourism Committee (Chairman Maloney and Legislators Maio, Roberts, Loughran, Wishnick) offers the following:

WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Tourism, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Legislature has funds available for tourist promotion agencies in New York State for advertising and promoting tourism, and

WHEREAS, designation as the official tourism promotion agency of Ulster County will allow the Department of Tourism to apply for and receive matching funds on behalf of the County for the State 2012-2013 NYS fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development and Tourism Committee has met and reviewed said request with a majority of the members voting approval, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby designates the Ulster County Department of Tourism Office as the official tourist promotion agency of Ulster County thereby making it eligible to apply for and accept matching tourism promotion funds on behalf of Ulster County during the New York State fiscal year 2012-2013, and to represent Ulster County for the promotion of tourism,

and moves its adoption.
