WHEREAS, this resolution has been submitted by the County Executive on behalf of the Ulster County Department of Tourism, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Legislature has funds available for tourist promotion agencies in New York State for advertising and promoting tourism, and

WHEREAS, designation as the official tourism promotion agency of Ulster County will allow the Department of Tourism to apply for and receive matching funds on behalf of the County for calendar year, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Ulster County Legislature hereby designates the Ulster County Department of Tourism Office as the official tourist promotion agency of Ulster County thereby making it eligible to apply for and accept matching tourism promotion funds on behalf of Ulster County during calendar year 2013, and to represent Ulster County for the promotion of tourism,

and moves its adoption.
